

Associate Membership Policy

(Approved 3/19/2024)

Per the Educational Technology Collaborative (ETC) Bylaws Article IV, Section 2.ii, an Associate Membership is defined as an organization or individual not otherwise eligible for Institutional or Corporate membership within ETC. Qualifications and privileges of an Associate member shall be determined by the Board of Directors.

Purpose:

This policy defines who is eligible for an associate membership and the privileges of such membership.

Eligibility:

Institutions of higher education are defined as post-secondary degree- or certificate-granting organizations.

Associate Membership is available for individuals or organizations with an interest in educational technology who are not employed by or are not otherwise institutions of higher education such as but not limited to museums; architects; public libraries; public or private K-12 schools; religious, governmental, non-profit, or other organizations; or as consultants to these organizations.

Retirees are eligible for Associate Membership but may also consider application for Life Membership.

Students are eligible for Associate Membership.

Privileges:

An Associate member is not eligible to participate in governance of ETC, which includes voting or holding elected office, but is eligible for all other benefits of membership.

Application for Membership:

Application for Associate memberships shall be submitted online. Eligibility shall be determined by the Executive Office.
